A word with Oliver Schlick

An interview with the incredibly versatile author

A shy detective, a missing crime novelist, an inventor who has problems with arithmetic and a crazy nonsense - Which of your characters are like you and do you have a personal favourite?

As a temporarily shy crime writer with a pronounced weakness in arithmetic and a penchant for nonsense, there's a little bit of me in all of my characters. The closest to me is certainly the Rory, the shy detective. Besides shyness and a fascination for puzzles, we also share one or two quirks and foibles. Although I would like to stress that, unlike the detective, I rarely lick radiator bonnets or stair railings. Rory and Matilda are investigating their latest crime case in the literary world: A crime writer has disappeared and the publisher is a suspect.

Assuming it is not the publisher, who else could have done it - and why? The editor? The bookseller?

Hard to say. There is of course a wide spectrum of motives. I hope the question is really just a question – and not a warning in disquise. Should I be on my quard for future visits to publishers and readings in bookshops?

If you were to go into hiding, where would we look for you?

The best chance of finding me is in St Mary Mead. Just ask in the village shop for the dodgy newcomer with coloured glasses who has bought up all their liquorice.

In "Als Dr. Möhrke durch Zufall den Unsinn erfand" (When Dr. Möhrke Accidentally Invented Nonsense), an experiment goes badly wrong - do you remember the last time something didn't go according to plan?

This happens almost every time I am confronted with any technology that's more complex than a coffee machine. Often accompanied by the sentence: "Why are those lights flashing so strangely all of a sudden?"
